## Blu-Tack Colour

### Description

Permanently plastic, reusable multi purpose adhesive and modelling material. Excellent adhesive qualities. Very Pliable. Non-toxic.

### Recommended Uses

Blu-Tack Colour is recommended for use on non-porous surfaces such as vinyl coated wallpapers, painted surfaces, glass, metal etc.

Blu-Tack Colour has a myriad of uses around the home, office, school, factory or workshop.

Number of uses are endless but here are some examples:-

- Create 3D models or fantastic murals on your window or wall.
- Hold up posters, cards, children's paintings, certificates, party decorations, maps, messages, etc.
- Holds in place telephones, mouse mats, calculators, ornaments to shelves, photos in albums, screws to screw drivers, holds model parts in position for painting or gluing, and picture frames straight.
- Safely stores pins, keys, screws and other small objects.
- Use in floral arrangements to keep flowers in place.
- Clean fluff from fabric and dirt from computers, model railway tracks or remove dust from hard to get at places.
- Use as a putty to block out breezes.

# Blu-Tack Colour

## Surface Preparation

1. Wash hands before use.
2. Ensure surfaces are clean, dry free from grease and loose materials.

## Application

Blu-Tack Colour works because its pressure sensitive:

1. For non-laminated surfaces make a 'blob' by tearing off a piece, pull and stretch into a ball and apply to one surface.
2. For laminated surfaces cut off 3-5cm pieces of Blu-Tack Colour, remove the release paper on one side, apply to one surface, then remove the other release paper.
3. Using good thumb pressure, apply to the other surface.

## Removal

To remove Blu-Tack Colour, roll it carefully off the surface. If it has been there for some time, soften with a citrus based stain remover (Di-Solv-It Sticky Spots or lighter fluid) and then roll off. Any remaining shreds can be removed by rolling or dabbing a blob of Blu-Tack Colour over the surfaces.

## Limitations

- Do not use Blu-Tack Colour on absorbent, silk screen printed or hand stencilled wallpaper nor on porous brickwork.
- Care should be taken on painted plaster as Blu-Tack Colour's adhesive qualities may cause paint to come away from wall.

## Storage & Shelf Life

Store away from heat, strong oxidising agents and acids.  
Store between 5°C to 30°C.

## PRECAUTION

The adhesive properties of Blu-Tack Colour increase over time, so take extra care when removing after a period of months. On some surfaces Blu-Tack Colour can leave an oily mark but this can often be removed using De-Solv-It Sticky Spots, Stain Remover or lighter fluid. Before using these products, we recommend you test on a small inconspicuous area. Not suitable to support heavy objects. 0.5g holds 105g of load.
