## 1. Description

Mr Gorilla Graffiti Remover is a user friendly solution designed to remove certain types of graffiti from surfaces. Mr Gorilla Graffiti Remover has been specifically blended to produce a product capable of easily removing graffiti caused by paint, including spray cans and marker pens. This product is very effective in the removal of paint, so where graffiti appears on a pre-painted surface; some of this coating will be removed, along with the graffiti. The solvent blend acts very quickly and has a fast evaporation rate.

## 4. Applications

Removal of graffiti caused by paint, including spray cans. Ideal for bricks, concrete, metal and wooden surfaces. May be used on previously painted surfaces, where the removal of this coating is not a problem.

## 6. Shelf Life

12 months in unopened packaging in a cool and dry storage place at temperatures between +5°C and +25°.

## 7. Application Instructions

The method of removal depends on the type of surface, and the size and nature of the graffiti. Apply Mr Gorilla Graffiti Remover only to the graffiti. Allow to penetrate the graffiti. Wipe off graffiti with a dry cloth. On stubborn graffiti remove with a brush or scrubbing implement. Rough surfaces such as bricks can be effectively cleaned using Mr Gorilla Graffiti Remover and a brick cleaning brush. Several applications may be necessary, depending on the surface. A small section of the graffiti should be tested prior to total removal.

*Soudal recommends preliminary compatibility tests on surfaces on which PU Foams have not been applied previously.*

## 8. Health and Safety Recommendation

- Apply the usual industrial hygiene.
- Ensure adequate ventilation during use. Where appropriate, mask in confined areas. Avoid contact with skin and eyes; wear gloves and glasses during use.
